





I have a dream! Why can't I?

I have a dream, that one day a Ukrainian child, a boy or a girl, will be proud and not afraid of being a Ukrainian child, of living in a country with equal possibilities and respectful obligations, with secured future and protected rights, among which are Life, Liberty, and the pursuit of Happiness.

I have a dream that freedom and dignity, for the whole world and not only for one country, will become more than just a couple of nice words, but the fundamental principles of our new reality emerged from the ashes of all previous centuries. That everyone will have a right for them. That all will have an obligation to respect them.

I have a dream, that tomorrow we will meet in the streets of our cities and villages; that chestnut trees will bloom again on the Khreshchatyk, and that spring will prevail in Kharkiv, Chernihiv, Donetsk, Luhansk, Mariupol, and Sevastopol; that there will be hope in our eyes, and that our hearts will be filled with faith in a new day and a new world. I have a dream that bright light of morning sunrise will chase away dark horrors of the war and we will find in ourselves sufficient courage to love again. We will cry, but with tears of joy.

I have a dream that no rains will be able to wash away from our consciousness a memory of that guy and that girl that never came back from a battle. That their children will never feel themselves orphans. I have a dream that none of those whose closest and dearest ones were cunningly stolen by the war will feel lonely. I honestly hope they will be proud to belong to one great unbreakable and invincible family of the free and the faithful.

I have a dream! Why not?

I do believe in a new dawn over the free land of the brave people!

And despite the fact that air bombs can destroy bridges and roads, and rockets can turn to ashes residential houses filled with people, and missiles and mines can demolish bread factories, kindergartens, hospitals, schools and churches, and their sharp and fiery fragments with swarms of russian bullets can penetrate and distort innocent human bodies, they can't destroy a dream!

My dream...

I have a dream! And what about you?..

The View From Up Here - March 20, 2022

"Master, Teach us How to Pray"

"He was praying in a certain place, and when He had ceased, one of his disciples said to Him, 'Lord, teach us how to pray, as John taught his disciples.' And He told them, "When you pray, say:" (Lk 11-1) And He then taught them "His prayer", the Lord's Prayer, the Our Father: "Our Father Who art in heaven, hallowed be Thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done on earth, as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one."

This was then followed by Our Blessed Lord teaching them (and us) that our prayer must be fervent and persistent. He also taught them (and us) that our prayer is always heard! "Ask and it will be given you. Seek, and you will find; knock and it will be opened to you." (Luke 11:8)

My Dear Fellow Climber, these days the word prayer has become a very common and overused word. In the overuse, it very often loses the power usually associated with "Prayer." We are especially praying for the people of Ukraine and for the casting out of evil from that special and beautiful land. Everywhere we go, we see signs: "Pray for Ukraine"! We have been greatly encouraged by our spiritual leaders to "Pray for **Ukraine.**" And we all, in our souls, have heard the call to "Pray for Ukraine". Sometimes when we are asked to pray for some person who may have a certain need or intention we always agree. Sure we'll pray, but how will we pray....."You'll be in our thoughts and prayers." Yes, we'll pray for Ukraine. Great, but how and when? Because the word prayer is so much used these days there is a danger that it lose the meaningful power of the word.

I am reminded of Father Baker. He always carried a little notebook and when anyone ever asked him for prayer, he would immediately put the name in his book, eventually say a special prayer for the intention, and when he had completed the request, he noted that in his little book. He took prayer requests very seriously! And we must also!

So how do we pray for requests for ourselves and for others? First of all, we take the request for prayer

seriously. Never let the words, "Pray for me!" come with an empty promise. We sit down, or better yet, fall on our knees and pray for that special need for whatever the intention. Certainly, the Lord's prayer, the "Hail Mary" are part of this intercessory prayer, however it must go beyond "thoughts." Do you have a prayer book, especially one for various needs and circumstances? There are many that are very good to have. See your priest if you have any questions about a good prayer book as there are many fine ones in print. Remember the spiritual treasure of "My Divine Friend."? Prayers for everything and everybody! It is good to pray from the heart, but also we need the spiritual wisdom of the holy ones who have gone before us and who have already given us prayers we can use.

I am writing this today specifically so all of us are reminded of our call to pray for Ukraine, the Ukrainian people and indeed all the world! Not only have the spiritual leaders asked us to pray, but our Blessed Mother, wherever and whenever she appeared has always asked us for fervent prayer and repentance. Today, I would like to pass on to you some "formal" prayers that I hope you can begin to say, so that we will truly be "praying"! The prayers are from a priest friend of mine who has passed them on for our use.

O Master Almighty, Lord of great mercies! Receive our prayer on bended knees and our humble tears, which we bring before Thy Holy Altar in these days of poverty and sorrow for Thy people. Accept the intercessions of all the saints of our Ukrainian land, whom we now call upon for help and intercession, so that the light of Thy love, manifested on Thy Cross, would enlighten every person suffering in this world in the darkness of enmity and iniquity.

Accept the intercession of the Holy and Blessed Prince Vladimir, the baptizer and enlightener of our land; receive the prayer of the Holy Passion-bearers Boris and Hlib, who have taught us never to raise our hands against our brother: receive the intercession of Thy saints Anthony and Theodosius of the Caves Monastery in Kiev, and with them all the venerable monks and nuns, who by tears of repentance made their souls whiter than snow; accept the heroic struggles of the New Martyrs and Confessors, especially those who suffered and died under the Soviet yoke, who through their holy labors

have preserved our saving faith in Thee; accept the petitions of all the saints of Thy Church who have us! sanctified our Ukrainian land with their labors and holy lives. Most of all, accept the prayerful protection of Thy Most pure Mother, our Lady Theotokos and Ever-Virgin Mary, for her fervent intercession!

Hear us. O God our Savior, and be merciful, O Master. unto all the suffering and burdened, and forgive our debts, teaching us to forgive those who are debtors, and replace Thine anger with Thy mercy, taking away all evil, sorrow and strife from the land of Ukraine, for Thou alone art good and the Lover of Mankind, and unto Thee do we send glory, to the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit, now and ever and unto ages of ages. Amen.

We pray for those who have died because of the war in Ukraine, especially those buried without the prayers of the Church. Be merciful to them, O Lord our God and give them rest in that place where there is neither sickness nor sorrow, but only Life Everlasting! Hear us, O Lord, and have mercy!

We pray for a quick cessation of hostilities against Ukraine, and that peace will guickly come again, we pray, hear us, O Lord, and have mercy!

We pray. O Lord. our God. for all those who suffer from this terrible and unjust war. We pray for Thy peace and Thy mercy in the midst of the great suffering of Thy people. Vouchsafe to accept the prayers of Thy Church, so that by Thy goodness, peace may quickly and speedily return to Ukraine, and all peoples, hear us. O Lord, and have mercy!

We pray, O Lord our God, remember all involved in that violent conflict. Grant mercy, life, peace, health and salvation to all those suffering, wounded, grieving or displaced, hear us O Lord and have mercy!

Give comfort to your children, O All-Immaculate Lady: subdue the cruel assaults that beset us all. Rescue us from every affliction, for in you alone do we have as an immovable and certain fortress, and we run to thy protection. Let us not be abandoned. O Ladv. we who call on you: hasten to our prayers, we, who in faith cry to you, our Holy Mother! Rejoice O sovereign Lady, the help of all, our joy, our protection and the salvation of our souls! We have no other defender, no other gracious consoler but Thee. O Mother of God. guard and protect

us forever. Most Holy Mother of God protect us and save
