

Glory to Jesus Christ! Glory Forever!

October 7, 2012 A.D.

Dear (say your name here for your very own personal letter),

Greetings from beautiful downstate New York and the õFall Clergy Days for the Eparchy of Stamford.ö After a long day, we arrived Monday night just in time to grab some of the leftovers from the nightly õfraternity gathering.ö The fact of leftovers being there was in itself a minor miracle, and we were grateful, as we had missed supper.

We gather each evening in the lounge of the main building settling down by the TV or the fireplace to share some snacks such as pizza or other õfinger foodsö as well as a few adult beverages. It been cool enough and already the management had a very nice, almost roaring fire, in the big fireplace. During meals, and especially at those nightly gatherings, is when everyone gets reacquainted and can take the opportunity to catch up on the news and events of life in the parishes. Recently transferred priests always seem to search out their replacements and compare notes with each other as they speak about the former and new parishioners.

Shortly after our arrival it began to rain and, so far, it been a very nice and beneficial rain for this area. God has been giving the earth a very nice drink. The rains have continued, off and on, even heavy at times, until today, which is Wednesday. It is now mid afternoon, still misty and damp, with the clouds lying very low on the mountains, but every once in awhile we see those hopeful breaks in the clouds. We always want a nice dry highway for our trip back to Buffalo, but for now, the scenery of the shrouded mountains is quite fascinating and so beautiful. The changing leaves take on a new beauty and color in the dim light and gray glow of the clouds.

Our daily schedule gives us a nice stretch of free time after lunch and, if the quietness of the facilities is any indication, a lot of the Fathers, especially those who once studied or lived in Brazil and Rome, must be having -siesta time. Igm writing to you as I sit outside in the fresh air under cover of one of the beautiful wooden gazebos.

So far, I realize Iowe just written about eating and sleeping. © Well, we did other things, too. We did pray our morning prayers each day and before noon everyone gathered for daily Liturgy down the hill at the church of The Holy Trinity, which as you may know is located on the Soyuzivka property.

Seriously though, this clergy gathering has been more serious and intense than most. It is far from routine, that for sure. The reason being, as you may already know, is that we have been called together to discuss and begin to implement the goals of Patriarch Sviatoslav pastoral letter, The Vibrant Parish-a place to encounter the living Christ. Actually, we began this discussion with the first half of His Beatitude letter when we had our spring clergy days in May of this year. At that time, we had in depth discussions regarding the first three points of the letter. Now during these recent days we have been meeting and delving into the second part of that very important and historical document which has the potential to be on breath of fresh airo for our Church.

A long time ago when I had first arrived in Buffalo, and prior to ordination, I was working at a chemical recycling company in the area. That small business was the brainchild of an exceptional, and extremely talented man of the Ukrainian community, Dr. Ignatius Metil, of blessed memory. He, along with several others, established this fledgling company as a new idea to begin othe Green Worldö by solving the problem of what to do with chemical waste. And at that time, we had a LOT of chemical waste on

the Niagara Frontier! Anyway, we handled just about everything from arsenic to zinc, everything in between, and all the compounds those things created when those little molecules attached themselves to one another!

Because the materials we handled had their own individual hazards all of the workers were required to wear hard hats, safety glasses and chemically resistant rubber coats, pants, boots and gloves as precaution against whatever would be brought in for disposal. We looked like a bunch of aliens most of the time, very hot aliens in summer. After a while though, we became accustomed to our daily dress in the workplace where the labor was hard, always hazardous and sometimes downright dangerous.

One summer, however, these men, who during the week looked as if they just stepped off of ETøs craft, were invited to a company picnic. And they came, not in the outfits of the chemical yard, but in ordinary summer dress. Not only did they come, but their wives and children also. They looked so different! I was amazed at their ordinaryo appearance and even mildly shocked seeing them looking so mormal. It realized that day, at that picnic, that they bore all those hazards and difficulties for those around them. It was for their wives and children and families that they did what they did in order to bring about that quest for olife, Liberty and the Pursuit of Happiness. Under all that neoprene rubber of the workplace was a devoted and loving father, husband or son wishing and striving for only a better life for himself and those he loved.

Every good person, man or woman, who gives that õgood day¢s work, for a good day¢s payö is the same as those men. It doesn¢t matter what the line of work is. It could be the policeman or fireman or doctor, lawyer or Indian chief, but they all give their lives for the good and betterment and growth of their family.

Imm telling you this story because I want you to know, that as I heard the discussions of what it means to have a vibrant parish and how we should go about having that vibrant parish, I also saw and heard a tremendous outpouring of love for you, the parishioners and the family of your priests. Often we are covered in all kinds of õprotective gearö which covers up our real person, and often as we go about the business of our daily lives we can easily forget the true goals and true calling of what our job really is all about. I wish all of our parishioners could be \(\frac{1}{2}\) a fly on the wall\(\text{of or these}\) clergy gatherings, especially these current ones regarding Patriarchøs õVision for 2020.ö You would see your priest as one who truly loves you and the parish to which he is assigned. You would see your priest caring for and nurturing the souls under his care. You would see your priest grieving for those who have gone away. You would see your priest as the loving father looking down the road and waiting for the prodigal to come back home. You would see your priest as the one willing to face the dangers and hazards and obstacles of life so that you will be safe and secure in your life-giving faith. You would see your priest as the one who will join hands with you and walk to the Kingdom. You would see your priest as truly loving and caring and concerned for your soul.

My dear one, I think this õVibrant Parish stuffö is really a breath of the Holy Spirit which will bring about a new life in our parishes and in our world-wide church. All of us, clergy and laity, as we walk in Christian love are now in very exciting times for our country and our Church. Watch and pray! Something wonderful is happening and all of us are part of it! I pray you will continue to walk to the Kingdom as part of your special parish and place in life! We are Christian; we are Catholic. Our God is with us!
