

Метрополит Андрей Шептицький

Зі своєї молодисти Митрополит Андрей відзначався побожністю. У одному листі до своєї мами він так писав: "Ви не можете собі уявити, як мені подобається все що мале, старе і немічне."

Постійно допомагав тим що потребували помочі, незалежно чи були вони одного віроісповідання чи іншого, такої національности чи іншої. Ціле своє боголюбиве життя старався він про єдність нашої церкви. Він бачив її тяжкі страждання але також її майбутній розквіт, якого початок ми є свідками сьогодні.

Ще довго потриває, щоб наша церква стала на свої ноги як слід, але за молитвами Слуги Божого скорше чи пізніше прийде до того. І не важне, що він ще не проголошений блаженним, і на це прийде час, але важне, щоб за словами Слуги Божого Патріярха Йосифа, молилися ми не про нього, але до нього, бо якщо ми не будемо визнавати його святим, інші також не будуть. Для нас він є святим. Проголошення його блаженним або пізніше святим, нічого не змінить у його єдності з Господом, і в його опіці над нашою церквою і над нашим народом.

Зі спогадів мами довідуємося, що Роман, це було хресне ім'я Слуги Божого, мав від малку нізмі. нахил до самовідречення і жертви. Найбільшу роздумуючи про Христові страсті. Знаний нам, один його рисунок, з якого багато розуміємо про Слугу Божого. Це рисунок Христа який несе тяжкий хрест, а коло нього багато інших хрестів. Це наші хрести, яких нам Христос помагає нести.

Митрополит Андрей Шептицький народився 22 липня 1865 року в селі Прилбичі на Львів-

щині. Походив зі стародавнього знатного укра-

їнського роду, який у XIX столітті зазнав полонізації, члени родини стали

франкомовними римо-католика-

ми. Незважаючи на сильну опозицію з боку батька, він вирішує повернутися до свого коріння і стати ченцем Василіянського чину, щоб служити нашій Церкві.

1899 він стає єпископом Станіславівським, а 31 жовтня 1900 року у пресі з'явилось офіційне підтвердження про номінацію єпископа Андрея Шептицького Галицьким Митрополитом, який

обдарований надзвичайними духовними харизмами невтомно трудиться, щоб примирити різні етнічні групи, і залишає по собі багату спадщину творів на тему суспільних проблем і духовности. Розробляє нові методи служіння. Засновує чин Редемптористів та монастирі Студійського Уставу інші релігійні згромадження. Він стає фундатором лічниці, Національного музею, Богословської Академії, надає грошову допомогу різним релігійним культурним та освітнім установам.

Митрополит Андрей був покровителем митців, студентів, в тому числі і багатьох православних християн, а також піонером в екуме-

Save the Baby Humans by Father Ray Palko

Outrageous! How can that be?! We will not stand for it! We will not allow it!

"There was a deer, still alive, impaled on three of these prongs, squirming, thrashing, trying to get herself off...." (June 14, 2013 WIVB) I am recalling this reported incident of some three years ago when the poor deer had failed to make the jump over a pointed fence and suffered such a horrible death. If you recall, it was a cemetery fence (one mile long) in Amherst. This account became the leading news story on TV and was often reported in the papers. Of course, the reporters made it sound as if it were a daily occurrence, and deer were dying in great numbers all along the mile-long fence. While not minimalizing this terrible death, I am sure only a very few (2 or 3 at most?) of these animals actually suffered these dire consequences. However, from the public outcry you would never suspect that.

There was great community outrage... Facebook and Twitter were burning up with protest! Individuals and groups mobilized, the TV stations regularly reported on it, (most likely the lead story), the newspapers had regular articles, and all were untiring in their efforts to change the situation. Not one more deer would be allowed to die because of that historic fence! Because of those very strong protests, the solution was to cut off all the spikes on the fence to save any deer who might not make the jump cleanly. As far as I know, these days the deer in Amherst are alive, happy and safe.

- Then we recall the TV and news stories that continued for months and months with reports and updates of a puppy named Phoenix deliberately set on fire. The dog had suffered serious burns, but survived. He 'rose from the ashes,' hence the name Phoenix.
- Shortly after that came the sad story of a big strong man beating and kicking his little five-pound dog. Again, the defenseless animal was seriously injured and had broken bones, damaged eyes and swelling to the body.

- Then an account telling us how the SPCA entered a home and seized over 100 animals from an abusive owner whose lack of proper care caused immense hurt and suffering to the various species supposedly in his care.
- Later on it was reported several young people tortured and burned a snapping turtle as they laughed and video-taped themselves in the act.
- After that we heard of the betrayal of the animals in a protective shelter. Supposedly placed in a safe haven the dogs, cats and other animals were physically abused by a worker where they were housed.
- Just this past week the SPCA had to rescue 47 cows, 2 pigs, some ducks and many, many cats. The farm owner was financially or physically incapable of caring for all those poor dependent helpless

Every one of these stories has two very important characteristics - EXTREME SUFFERING of defenseless living beings and OUTRAGE! When these, and so many other stories of animal abuse come to light, we are naturally appalled and sickened by such accounts, and we all want to do whatever we can to stop the neglect, suffering and violent and horrible deaths of these poor, innocent and vulnerable animals. It is absolutely amazing to witness the incredible response of people as they come together and offer their time, talent and treasure and say, "NO MORE! THIS MUST STOP! THOSE RESPONSIBLE MUST BE BROUGHT TO JUSTICE! THE ANIMALS MUST BE RESCUED FROM THOSE HORRENDOUS SITUATIONS!" THIS MUST NOT HAPPEN IN A CIVILIZED SOCIETY! People join forces in their disgust and outrage. The TV stations and newspapers keep the stories in the headlines until the lives of the poor animals can be saved. When a situation is so that the animals have died, the protesters do not rest until they have assurances that the circumstances have changed and not one more animal will die because of abuse or neglect.

Yes! We must save the animals! We must be outraged! And rightly so! Yes we are sickened and outraged to see or hear about a deer impaled on a fence. We are deeply disturbed by the great suffering abuse.

we saw the horrible videos of the people from Planned Parenthood as they discussed the sale of St. Teresa of Calcutta body parts of those poor, innocent, defenseless

BABY HUMANS. Oh there was some outrage; there was some reporting. But definitely not close to the outrage or reporting about animals. Something is very wrong and upside down about our "civilized society!"

Each year in the USA over one million Preborn Baby Humans are murdered in the womb. Where is the outrage? Where is the horror? If you think it is horrible to hear the sounds of a tortured animal or see it ripped apart.

what about the Baby Humans? If you can't stand the sounds of the suffering, dying animal, what about "The Silent Scream of Abortion?" If you can't stand the sight of all those dead animal bodies, what about the modern Holocaust of the Murder of Preborn Baby Humans? If you can't stand the sight of a deer Choose therefore life, that thou mayest live, both impaled on a fence, what about the sight of a doctor pulling a baby from the mother's womb and pushing scissors in the back of the child's head for the United States of America, we beseech you to pray express purpose of killing him or her?!

But more importantly, so do humans. If it is outrageous, horrible and unthinkable to tear apart or torture an animal, how much more evil is it to do that to a Preborn Baby. We must do everything in our power to stop the murder of our helpless, innocent Preborn Humans. In a few days we will have the opportunity, like those activists who spoke up for the deer or cows, "to do something." We truly have an opportunity to save lives. We must VOTE! We must vote for Jesus Christ, Son of God, and His teaching. We must vote for Life! We must vote to end the unbelievable and evil scourge on this country, "the New Holocaust," "the Silent Scream."
